South Port Day Links provides services to older people, people with a disability and their carers. On occasion we can support people who are outside our main client group for short term assistance due to an unexpected injury or other related health concerns. This is managed on a case by case basis.

The DayLinks service does not transport people in a wheelchair; we are unable to transport children.

We can support people who use wheelie walkers who can access the DayLinks service.

To be eligible for our services you need to be a resident of the City of Port Phillip.

Clients requesting a service need to be assessed over the phone and those who are aged 65 years and over need be registered with My Aged Care to be access the service.
